1) Car Parking is provided on site.

CRITERION 2 - Approach to dwelling from parking

② There is a gently sloping ramped access approach to the entrance.

CRITERIA 3 - Approach to entrances

③ There is a gently sloping ramped access approach to rear the entrance.

4 CRITERION 4 - Entrances
 a) Be illuminated, b) Have level access over the threshold; and
 c) Have effective clear opening widths and nibs as specified below.
 In addition, main entrances should also:
 d) Have adequate weather protection,e) Have a level external landing.

CRITERION 6 - Internal doorways and hallways

The width of the doorways and hallways will conform with Lifetime Homes standards.
All doors have a 300mm nib

To Space for turning a wheelchair is provided in dining areas and living room with adequate circulation space for wheelchars elsewhere.

CRITERION 7 - Circulation Space

CRITERION 8 - Entrance level living space

8 The living space is at entrance level.

CRITERION 9 - Potential for entrance level bed-space

There is space on the entrance level for a bed space.

CRITERION 10 - Entrance level WC and shower drainage

There is a wheelchair accessible WC at entrance level and a drainage provision is made enabling a shower to be fitted in the future.

CRITERION 11 - WC and bathroom walls

(1) Walls in the shower room and toilet will be capable of taking apdaptations such as hand rails.

CRITERION 12 - Stairs and potential through-floor lift in dwelling

a) Potential for stair lift installation; and, b) A suitable identified space for a through-the—floor lift from the entrance level to a storey containing a main bedroom and a bathroom satisfying Criterion 14.

CRITERION 13 - Potential for fitting of hoists and bedroom / bathroom

3 Structure above the bedroom will be capable of supporting ceiling hoists and a convenient route to the bathroom has been identified.

CRITERION 14 - Bathrooms

An accessible bathroom, providing ease of access in accordance with the specification below, should be provided in every dwelling on the same storey as a main bedroom.

Either a bath or an accessible floor level shower.

Floor drain under bath unless provided elsewhere in the dwelling.

CRITERION 15 - Glazing and window handle heights

(15) Windows in the princile living space allows people to look out when seated. At least one window can be opened and useable by a wide range of people including people with restricted movement.

CRITERION 16 - Location of service controls

Service controls will be within a height of 450mm-1200mm and at least 300mm away from any internal corner.
