- successfully fought against the proposed development of the Cedarhurst site on Elstree Hill,
- organised petitions against some other local development proposals on behalf of members,
- organised an Annual General Meeting, addressed by Colin Moynihan, MP, Minister of Sport,
- made our views known to the Local Authorities on a wide range of subjects.
