



Of our Meridian Markers in Farnaly Road on Sunday 9th April 2000 COME and JOIN US! The ceremony to unveil the Markers on the Greenwich Meridian by the Mayor, Councillor Polydorou JP will take place at 4.00pm on Sunday 9th April 2000 in Farnaby Road near where the road crosses the Golf Course. Everyone interested is invited to come along to the ceremony.

Following the unveiling, there will be a reception in Shortlands Golf Club (wine and/or tea and nibbles). There will also be a series of display panels describing our area, our history and giving an account of the Society's principal activities since it was formed in 1987.

Unfortunately because of the size of the room available, numbers at the reception are limited. After allowing for official guests etc. the remaining tickets will be available for Members on application. The AGM endorsed that the fairest way to allocate those tickets was to put a limit of 2 tickets per household and ask those who wanted to attend to send the attached form (page 3) to the Secretary by the 28th March 2000.

If the event is over subscribed, the available tickets will be "drawn out of a hat". That method was fully suported at the recent Annual General Meeting.
