BECKENHAM PLACE PARK

At the risk of pre-empting the Working party representative's report, I am sure that everyone will wish to know that Lewisham have severed negotiations with the preferred tenderer for the management of the park, buildings and golf course. The official reason is that Lewisham was not happy that the tenderer had or could, obtain financial backing for what they proposed to do in the time scale that Lewisham wanted them to do it. It is suspected that another reason could be that the tenderer kept on enlarging the proposals that he had made in his "best and final offer". Each enlargement reduced the likelihood of him getting planning approval - bearing in mind that we are talking about statutorily listed buildings and metropolitan open land..

For the foreseeable future Lewisham will continue to manage the park but, almost certainly, will sub-contract some aspects such as the golf course, catering, grassland management etc.
