Communication & Engagement

Met Engage is a single, clear, two-way communications channel that allows messages to be focused to the specific neighbourhood or interest group that officers wish to reach.

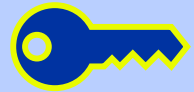
These updates are therefore relevant and are not lost among the many different messages coming from the MPS.



Crime Prevention

The tool enables targeted crime prevention and provides updates based on individual or local needs, giving the officers the ability to respond in a **'you said, we did'** fashion.

Key Features



Focused email alerts to specific neighbourhoods or interest groups, and allows them to respond



Showing police are listening and responding to individuals/communities – **'You said, We did'**



Survey tools that enable officers to understand local issues



Translate messages into 100+ languages



Enables community members to tell us where crimes and anti-social behaviour are happening in their area



Engagement tracker to monitor community meetings, surgeries (physical and online), community events



Ability to focus reassurance patrols or engagement to specific communities, and understand gaps in engagement
